LAEDC (Los Angeles County Economic Development Corporation)	Deep regional labor market expertise; co-author of workforce sector strategies; ideal for data-informed employer engagement
BizFed (Los Angeles County Business Federation)	Diverse industry representation across 200+ organizations; facilitates rapid employer feedback loops
Los Angeles Area Chamber of Commerce	Policy influences and strong ties to workforce development; supports inclusive hiring initiatives
Construction Industry Coalition (CIC)	Strategic for AJCCs focused on trades; supports pathway development for Women in Construction and Reentry populations
California Clean Energy Small Business Network	Aligns with Clean Energy COE; strong focus on equity and new sector hiring commitments
